Cayuga Marketing LLC is planning to develop an \$86MM +/-, 106K +/- square foot milk ingredients processing facility on an approximately 24-Acre development site within the Cayuga County Industrial Development Agency (CCIDA) Industrial Park located in the Town of Aurelius. The facility will produce milk protein concentrates & isolates and milk powders for the global food and nutrition industries. The facility will also produce liquid 42% cream and milk permeate concentrate (lactose). All of the fluid milk used in production will be procured from local farmer-owners, and we look to transform our local dairy resources into value-added agricultural products for sale into World markets.

The facility will create fifty-two (52), permanent, full-time employees (FTE) jobs, including highly skilled positions paying salaries over \$50,000 and more per year (\$70,000 with benefits). These net new jobs will be filled primarily with local workers. First year total payroll, inclusive of all benefits, is projected at \$2.67MM+. In addition to the 52 permanent FTE jobs required to operate the facility, another estimated 285 FTE construction-related jobs will be generated over 2 years; peripheral and indirect construction-related projects are estimated at 473+ jobs.

The plant will require 600,000,000 +/- lbs. of milk per year from local dairy farms, resulting in over \$85MM+ of payments to farms and generate approximately \$110MM+ in annual revenues. This will result in a local economic impact of over \$220MM. The facility has a targeted construction start of June 2012 with operations commencing within 18-24 months from start of construction.

Cayuga Marketing, LLC is having continued discussions with various potential equity partners to participate in a much more significant milk processing plant. The plant being discussed would purchase up to 3.6 million lbs. of milk daily from local and regional dairy farmers, totaling over \$160 MM in annual payments. The plant would require a \$115 MM investment over 24 months and would create an estimated 75 full time equivalent jobs. Total annual revenues would be approximately \$200 MM, creating a \$400 MM local economic impact.

Should an equity partner decide to invest, Cayuga Marketing, LLC will be seeking approval for a larger building to construct. Our engineering firm, Stahlman Group, has already designed the building and site map for the aforementioned project.

After the application has been reviewed and the Agency has agreed to schedule a public hearing, the project will be scheduled to appear before the full Agency Board for action. At the time the application is submitted to the Agency Board, an application fee of \$250 is due.

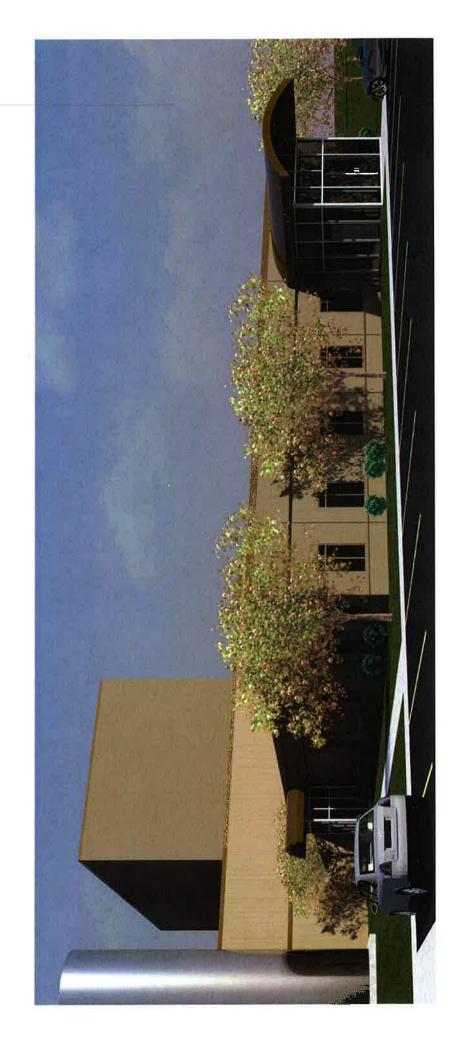

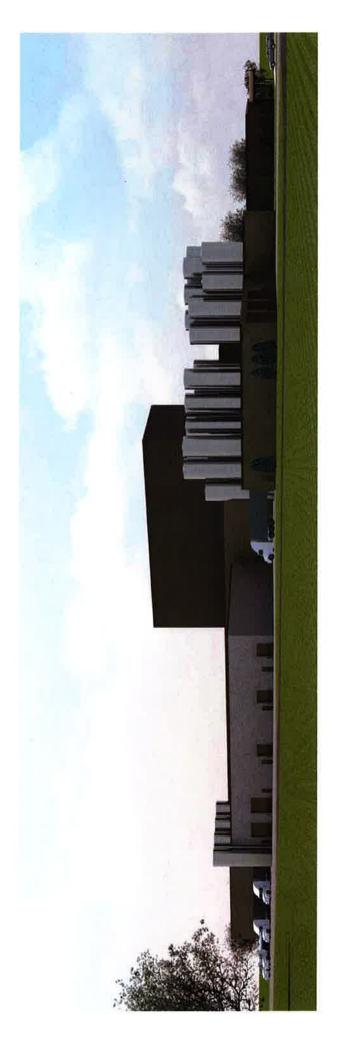
