

In 1978, the business had outgrown its location, and moved to the former family farm on Routes 5 & 20, where it remains today. In 1979 Doug's brother, Dave, became an equal partner in the business.

D&W Diesel, Inc. is a remanufacturer and distributor of diesel engine components, tank truck equipment, and industrial equipment. It has expanded its product lines from an original offering of only diesel engine components to a diverse array of products which now includes a wide variety of hose and couplings, pneumatic conveying equipment, vacuum and liquid pumps, hydraulic drive systems, tank truck accessories, and industrial products.
